

ARDENITES TO VOTE ON CONSOLIDATION PROJECT

A public meeting of residents of Arden will be held tomorrow night at 8 o'clock for the purpose of discussing the advisability of combining the recently purchased Harvey tract of 100 acres with Arden or of maintaining it as a separate village.

The purchasers of the Harvey tract have announced their intention of developing it as a separate entity, but wish to give it the name Ardentown. Residents of Arden oppose a name so similar to their own village and will discuss this question tomorrow night.

At the November meeting the Ardenites passed a resolution declaring that in the absence of complete consolidation between Arden and the Harvey tract there should be no degree of consolidation whatever. W. F. Kurtz is attorney for the trustees.
