

RULES FOR THE ARDENTOWN MEMORIAL GARDEN

The Ardentown Memorial Garden shall be for the burial of ashes only.

2-ELIGIBILITY

Any deceased person who has been a resident of Ardentown for at least five (5) years is eligible for burial. Former residents, having resided in Ardentown for at least five (5) years are eligible and may be considered for burial upon request to a representative of the Memorial Garden Committee.

3-BURIAL SITE

The burial site is to be selected by the Memorial Garden Representative and a member of the surviving family, in keeping with the future plans of the Memorial Garden.

4-DETAILS OF BURIAL

It is the responsibility of the surviving family to arrange for the excavation, depositing of ashes and the pouring of concrete for the marker.

5-MARKERS

Each burial site is to be provided with a marker at the time ashes are deposited. The size and shape of the markers will be specified by the Memorial Garden Committee. Markers must be firmly imbedded in cement and installed close to the ground.

6-SOIL

No soil is to be removed from the Memorial Garden

7-FLOWERS

No artificial flowers are to be used in the Garden. Burial site decorations are to be removed within two weeks of placement.

8-PLANTINGS

Permanent plantings are not permitted. The Memorial Garden Committee will arrange for all landscaping.

9-DONATIONS

In order to maintain the Memorial Garden, a donation from the family and friends of the deceased will be greatly appreciated. Although not mandatory, a yearly donation for the upkeep and improvement of the Memorial Garden will be gladly accepted. Donations should be made payable to Ardentown Memorial Garden.
