MINUTES - TOWN MEETING - SEPTEMBER 10, 1990

Called to order: quorum present.

Audit Committee: No report.

Memorial Garden Committee: was commended for the Dedication Program. J Brandner requested money for a record ledger. Allen Riblett will take the place of E Scott on this committee.

The second reading of the motion to transfer zoning authority from the Village of Ardentown to New Castle County was passed unanimously.

Trustee R Cherrin reviewed the current status of the Town's zoning case; a non-binding Resolution was moved, seconded & passed: that the Town Meeting support the Trustees in their actions in that matter.
